Sculptor **Brad Oldham** (pictured) is teaming up with the 2011 Chi Omega Christmas Market in the launch of his new limited-edition sculpture series featuring owls! Each silver-infused bronze sculpture depicts a specific breed. The three breeds set for introduction in 2011 are - a barn owl named Captain, a great horned owl named Walter and a couple of burrowing owls named John and Abigail. These 7" tall sculptures are mounted on a 1 1/2" mahogany base which houses a small book and a story - written by Oldham's wife Christy Coltrin - about the unique brand of owl.

The Oldhams will contribute 20% of all sales at the 2011 Market to COCM and will also offer an originally designed cuff bracelet with "HOOT" artistically reversed out. These original owls and jewelry concepts are certain to be sure hits with the Chi Omegas in attendance!
